

OSCEOLA COUNTY Sports Facilities



Osceola County is home to many prestigious championship golf courses, 96,708 acres of public access lakes and over 130 acres of park facilities that speak to every kind of sports traveler, with special emphasis on soccer, baseball, softball and fishing enthusiasts. Naturally, tourism remains the lifeblood of Osceola County, which has more than 42,000 hotel rooms. While theme parks remain the main draw, other attractions add a distinctive local appeal. Old Town and Boggy Creek Airboat Rides, to cite just two, deliver different and varied experiences that complement the big theme parks.



Osceola County Heritage Park features an 8,300 seat enclosed arena with 13 luxury suites and 33,946 square feet of floor space. The venue also houses an exhibition hall with 47,850 square feet of clear span exhibit space full service catering provided by SMG, and over 7,200 parking spaces.



Osceola County Stadium and Sports Complex is the spring training home of the Houston Astros and national headquarters for the USSSA. This complex boasts six full size baseball fields including the stadium and two half size practice fields. The stadium has 5,300 seats and complete clubhouse facilities, electronic video board, media boxes, public address system and high-quality lighting.



Osceola County Softball Complex features five immaculately groomed and landscaped fields in a cloverleaf satellite configuration. A self-contained, full service facility, the complex has electronic scoreboards, public address system, bleachers, high-quality lighting, modern batting cages and a three-story clubhouse that provides coaches, players and officials with comfortable locker facilities.



Austin-Tindall Regional Park is a modern complex designed to FIFA competition standards, Austin Tindall boasts eight regulation fields, five of which are lighted, and three practice fields. By Fall of 2016, a planned expansion will add two fields for a total of ten, as well as lights on all ten fields.



ESPN World Wide of Sports is a 220 acres athletic complex located in the Walt Disney World Resort. The complex includes nine venues, 17+ multipurpose fields, and hosts numerous amateur and professional sporting events throughout the year. Champion Stadium, home of the Atlanta Braves Spring Training, features 9,500 seats, four luxury sky boxes, and multiple open-air suites and patios. The 70,000+ square foot 5,000 seat HP Field House is home to the ESPN hosted Orlando Classic.
